To begin I give you a couple quotes from my son. He's not famous but he is a true patriot and loves digging into facts. *"The four boxes of Liberty are Soap Box, Ballot Box, Jury Box and Cartridge box (ammo), a last resort that any sane person would want to avoid, if at all possible".* Another, *"When a government official usurps their authority, as determined by the constitution, they are "acting in self-interest," not the interest of their position, their constituents, or our country. Hello LBRW, I hope you are all keeping warm as our weather turns a bit cooler. 2024 is in full swing, So much going on to begin this election year.

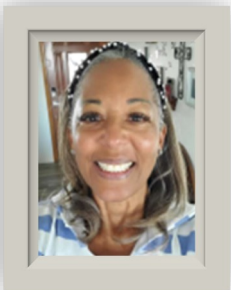
I have sent out a few cards this month. One

**SPOTLIGHT MEMBER—MARILOU ALEXANDER PERFETTI
DECEMBER 3, 1940**

I was born in a very little town called Wilmar, California – now days it is much bigger and called Rosemead. As was common in those days, both of my parents came from families of 9 children, and they all lived within a few blocks of each other. Mother's parents had 16 grandchildren for many years then a few of my aunts added to the count and there were 23. I say this so you will know I was raised with lots of family. I still love my cousins and try to keep up with them.

Then after the war (that I barely remember) we moved to Visalia, California. Mother and her 6 sisters stayed close, and we moved back and forth for many years. When I started high school, my parents, bought a wonderful house in Visalia and stayed settled till I graduated.

I did all the dumb things kids can do, married divorced, lived the high life for a while---then back to Rosemead and lived with my mother's parents when I was 21. A year later I met a wonderful guy – he was so smart, and knew everything, he was 26. (Not to mention tall, dark and handsome)

After job jumping for some years, we opened our own business in 1971. It was a Janitor Supply company. If you could have asked my husband Don what he did he would say I am a "toilet flusher". 1981 we sold the business and bumped around for a couple of years. Then in 1985 we open a new business, it was a wholesale Janitor Supply, called M.D. Wholesale in Los Angeles. I can't think of anything I didn't do. All the book work, billing, payroll and etc. Then I was a "road salesman" my territories were San Diego, some local areas, the bay area and Las Vegas. I am not the first woman in our industry to this, but I was certainly among the first. It was tiring and so much fun. Don and I were good salesmen and won many prizes from the factories we represented. A couple cruises out of Florida and one of my favorites a trip to New England for fall colors. I truly enjoyed all the travel we were able to do, trips to New York, New Hampshire, New Orleans, Texas, Boston, Minnesota, Wisconsin and Chicago.

Don died in 2005 and I couldn't wait to sell the business, no way could I do his job and mine. In September I sold my home in Arcadia, after 42 years and moved so I could have four seasons. Lake Wildwood is just a bit west of Grass Vally or halfway between Reno and Sacramento. I lived there 14 years and discovered I was just a step away from homeless.

The Gillette's (Richard and LaJuana) took me in. Gillette's had a large family, and like mine, many of them moved to Visalia like we did. Richard's sister, Nadine, married my oldest brother. I was about 9 years old when that happened, so I knew nearly all of the Gillette's.

Richard and I were the youngest in the families and we became good friends and kept up with each other, through the years. Then in March 2019 Richard sent his son to move me to Lake Havasu City. I didn't think Arizona was the best place in the world, but I was grateful. It has grown on me, and I am enjoying the many friends I have made, with LaJuana pushing me a bit. Just so you know two of my best friends are my cats, Boots and Harvey Baby, yes LaJuana had something to with that also.

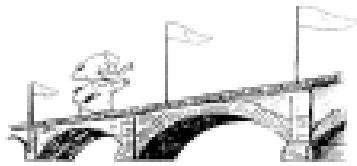

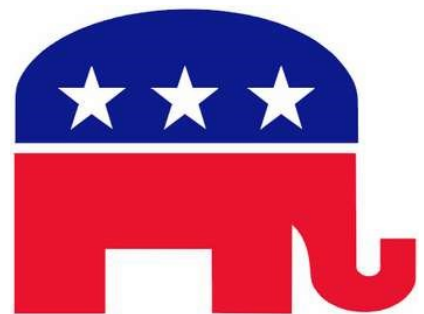
