#### Brett Baier must not moderate the Republican debate

Brett Baier is not qualified to moderate the Republican debate on August 23 in Milwaukee. Mr. Baier had a <u>much-publicized interview</u> with President Trump a month ago. This interview amply demonstrated Baier's antipathy toward the president. Most of the time, he appeared to be cordial towards the president; however, when Trump brought up the topic of the stolen election, Baier became abusively hostile and interrupted his guest incessantly and would not let the president talk.

Cavuto invariably has Chris Christie, Karl Rove, or Asa Hutchinson on just to bash President Trump, and all happily comply. Rove always has his whiteboard and manipulates facts to bash President Trump. He must not be anywhere near a camera or microphone.

One question at the debate will come up: "Will you support whoever will be the nominee?" I was born in Putnam, Ct, January 26, 1938 on a Wednesday morning at 1:10 am. I grew up in Putnam and was very active in school with softball, basketball & cheer leading. I'm the 3<sup>rd</sup> oldest child of ten so you must know that I did a lot of babysitting and helped around our home. Life as a child was very difficult but I won't go into this. I come from a small area called the 10 town area. I moved to Danielson, Ct. when I got married, which was only 10 miles from Putnam. Great area to live & raise children for we lived in the country. I stayed in that area till I moved to Arizona in 1980.

I discovered Lake Havasu in 1975. My husband & I flew out on a McCulloch flight from New York with friends who had already bought a lot here from McCulloch. Needless to say, in 1975, my husband & I bought a lot too. McCulloch would fly people out for free & you would stay in their Hotel which is now the Police Department & our City hall.

I had six children and was very involved with their activities of baseball, basketball, football, drill team, girl scouts, cub scouts & 4-H. I can't begin to tell you how many times I was a chaperone. I was the neighbor that did the driving from my house to the school for the activities. I was a 4- H horse leader & coached the girl softball team. The first year I coached the softball team we won the championship. I so enjoyed being involved in my children's lives. At this time, I was a stay at home Mom but worked only on a Friday what was called Fish Chip day. This gave me extra money for the kids.

I'm very sad to say that I lost my two middle children. On Dec.27, 1961 my youngest child Misti Dawn died at the age of 5 months from SIDS or what is called crib death. A little over 10 years later my daughter Cheri Lyn died at the age of almost 13 from a Brain Tumor. This wonderful child was ill for 3 years & died February 28<sup>t</sup> 1972 A very sad tragic time in our lives for many years. It felt like my whole life stopped. I knew I had to do something, I wasn't able to cope with much. I finally went to got help which was the best think I could have done. The other children needed me but I needed more in my life with losing Cheri, so I went to the school where she attended & applied for a job.

When my youngest child started school, I went to work in the school system as a certified teacher aide. I had around 6 to 10 children in two classrooms. My job was to try and bring their grades up to at least their grade level. Besides working and being busy with children & their activities I started night school at our community college. My goal back then was to become a teacher.

My husband kept begging me to move to Arizona but I wanted to wait till the 2 left at home had graduated. Needless to say, I finally gave in & said I'd move to Arizona.

On July 11th, 1980 my two children and our two dogs arrived in Lake Havasu City at 3:10 am. The other children stayed in Ct. for they were married and had already started their own lives. So here I am still in beautiful Lake Havasu City for over 43 years. In 1980 I had a job with Havasu Christian Pre-School & I taught pre-kindergarten. I

have to say another sad time in my life was 3 years after moving to this beautiful city, my husband went out of town to get another job & left my 2 girls & me here in Lake Havasu & never returned. I worked several jobs for several years to take care of my girls in order to be able to keep our home.

I knew then I needed to make more money, so I changed my career and decided to go into Real Estate and was very active till 2011. I tried to slow down but kept getting referrals so today I handle my past customers & referrals only due to the fact I'm now 85. I worked for the Developers of Lake Havasu City called MCO which was located in a beautiful 2 story building where CVS is now located. It was a fun place to work for many people were brought in from California & put up in a nice hotel for 2 nights & I got to tell them about how Lake Havasu came to be, We took them on a boat ride & many bought McCulloch lots from me. I did this for several years till they left town around 1989 and we became Coldwell Banker.

I always treated my clients like they were my good friends, of course most of them became my good friends. I believed in education, so I kept going to school to receive a few designations and my Broker's license. I have received many awards as a REALTOR® but the best award was when I was chosen to receive the REALTOR® Vision Award of the year IN 2005. I've always been active with our Association for it is the backbone for our REALTORS®. My son moved out here in 2003 and he became my partner. That is when I was asked if I would be willing to get involved again with the Association. I ran for Vice- President and then President-Elect and became President for the 2009 year. During this time, I was able to travel several times to Washington DC for our National Conventions. It's amazing what you learn at these seminars & the wonderful history one gets to see about our great Nation.

In 1987 I had saved enough money to get my daughter Monique in College. She attended Grand Canyon Christian University & received her Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing in 1991 I managed to get my daughter Denise back in college & she graduated from UNLV with a Bachelor of Arts degree in teaching.

Now it was my turn to save for me. I'm now able to treat myself to a nice trip once a year. In 1991 I did take my daughters Monique & Denise on a Caribbean Cruise for their Graduation present. In 1995 I started traveling with friends & on my 80<sup>th</sup> birthday I treated myself with my dear friend Terry Daley to a17 day Panama Canal Cruise & both of us celebrated our birthdays on the same day. We both went zip lining in Costa Rica & got to see 5 different countries.






