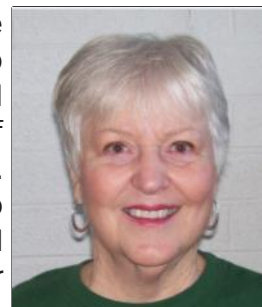

Council Corner by David Diaz, Vice Mayor



The following is a brief recap of current happenings regarding your LHC City Council activities

Airport Manager. We are negotiating an agreement with a company that provides airport management and other airport services. The company is Aviation Management Consulting Group (AMCG) and comes highly recommended by all of the airports we contacted who have done business with them. We are also continuing to bring the airport up-to-date with documents, policies, rules, regulations, minimum standards, new lease agreement template language, and updates to the City Code. When these steps are completed, we will be setting up our next airport manager up for success.

Career Fair. We're excited to host a City Career Fair on Friday, August 28, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the Aquatic Center's Rods and Relics Hall. Anyone interested in working for Lake Havasu City can meet with department representatives, learn about current openings, and see what a career in public service has to offer.

Hospital Water Improvements. Havasu Regional Medical Center (HRMC) successfully completed a scheduled total water shutdown on Monday, August 3, to perform critical water system repairs. The work included replacing a water softener, repairing pipes, and installing new shut-off valves and water lines. The Fire Department coordinated closely with HRMC and reviewed the Incident Action Plan to ensure emergency response readiness throughout the project. The repairs were completed without issue, and water service and hospital operations returned to normal.

Hazards Mitigation Plan. We are updating Lake Havasu City's sections of the Mohave County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazards Mitigation Plan to strengthen the City's emergency preparedness efforts. We have very capable City employees who can complete this work, so we will be doing it ourselves, and not soliciting a consultant to do the work. When completed, it will be presented to Council for its consideration.

Fuel Facility. The ribbon cutting for our new fuel facility was held earlier this month. The new facility will allow us to respond in emergency situations during a power outage, which would be a very real struggle without this facility. And, purchasing fuel in bulk will save us upwards of \$125,000 per year.

Construction Activity.

- Building permits were issued for Fire Station 7 and construction has started.
- Building permits are ready for pick-up for the Havasu Riviera Sixty-Seven and Pinnacle at Marina View subdivision projects.
- Currently in plan review is a new 21,782 square foot office/warehouse commercial building, located at 90 Retail Centre Blvd.
- An interior remodel and patio expansion for the Paradise Café is currently under plan review. It is located at 70 London Bridge Road in the Chemehuevi Terminal Building.
- Safeway is starting a tenant improvement and total refresh of the entire store, which includes removing Starbucks and replacing it with a new Drive Up and Go area.

Residential Care Facilities. In response to recently adopted State legislation, staff is preparing a Development Code text amendment for Residential Care Facilities to comply with Senate Bill 1473. The legislation prohibits cities and towns from restricting occupancy below 10 residents. The City's current code limits occupancy to 6 residents and will be updated to meet the new state requirement.

The LHC City Council is always here for your needs and concerns. Feel free to reach out at any time.

Rolling Stone declared in a headline, "Nothing About Trump and Natalie Harp Is Normal," while Forbes went more suspicious with its headline, "Natalie Harp Seen Everywhere With Trump Lately—Why That's Raising Questions."

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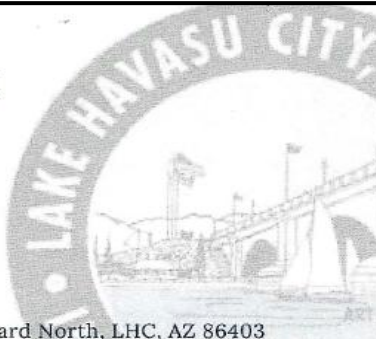
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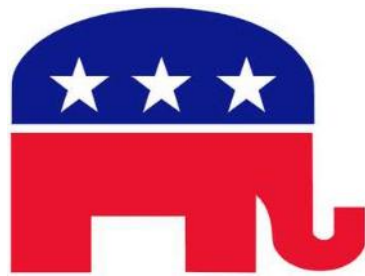
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
